	3. Read Matthew 5:14-16.
	4. Discuss these questions with your group. (20-45 min)
	"You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor dependent light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house." (Matthew 5:14-15)
	What are some natural ways to clearly identify with Christ?
	Why would some Christians want to hide their light and "stay under the radar" as Christ followers? Why is this spiritually unhealthy?
	In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven. (vs. 16)
	What are some different motivations for making sure people see the good things we are doing?
	How can we call attention to God's goodness through our good works?
	PLAN OF ACTION
	Make it a point to identify with Jesus this week, either in your words or actions. Remember, your motivation is to focus people's attention on God not you.
