NOTES	GROUP DISCUSSION 1. Open with prayer. (2-5 min) 2. Share your story What annoys you? What do you do that others might find irritating? (7-10 min) 3. Read 1 Peter 4:8-11. 4. Discuss these questions with your group. (20-45 min)
	Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. (1 Peter 4:8)
	Is it possible to love in a way that is not "earnest"? If so, what does that lool like? In what sense does love "cover" the sins of others? How can we do this without enabling unhealthy words and behaviors?
	Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. (vs. 9)
	What might cause us to resist being hospitable? Why does complaining defeat the whole purpose of hospitality?
	As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies. (vs. 10-11)
	What are your natural and spiritual gifts? How can you use them for the benefit of others? Why is it important to acknowledge that God, alone, is th source of our skills and abilities?
	—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. To him belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. (vs. 11)
