NOTES	GROUP DISCUSSION 1. Open with prayer. (2-5 min) 2. Share your story What has your relationship with the Holy Spirit been like up to this point in your life? (7-10 min) 3. Discuss these questions with your group. (20-45 min) 4. Read John 14:15-30, John 16:4-15
	You know [the Holy Spirit], for he dwells with you and will be in you. (John 14:17)
	What would you be unable to do without the Holy Spirit?
	How does the Holy Spirit make Himself known to you?
	Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for it I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. (John 16:7)
	Why did Jesus need to leave in order for the Holy Spirit to come?
	Is Jesus still with us, even though we have the Holy Spirit within us (as believers)? Explain.
	Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. (1 Corinthians 12:4-7)
	How have you been gifted by the Holy Spirit? How is Jesus using those gift to encourage and build us up at Crossroads?
