	complete that sentence? Have you ever been in a place where you
	said some version of this statement? If so, how did you complete the
	sentence? (7-10 min).
	3. Read John 11:1-44
	4. Discuss these questions with your group. (20-45 min)
	Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." (John 11:21)
	Now when Mary came to where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet, saying to him, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." (John 11:32)
	Why did Jesus respond to Martha and Mary differently, even though they made the same statement to him?
	Why is it important to figure out what someone really needs before attempting to help him or her?
	In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials. (1 Peter 1:6)
	Read 1 Peter 1:1-6. What is "this"—the thing in which we are to rejoice? What is it about this thing that makes sense of our suffering?
	How can a believer rejoice and be grieving at the same time?
