### MY STORY | Vulnerability

*Talk about a time when you “took a bullet” for someone? What were the consequences of that decision? (7-10 min)*

### DIGGING DEEPER | Practical Biblical Application

*The people stood by, watching [Jesus be crucified], but the rulers scoffed at him, saying, “He saved others; let him save himself, if he is the Christ of God, his Chosen One!” (Luke 23:35)*

*Pastor Matt said that Jesus could either save Himself, or save others—but could He not do both.*

Why are these two things mutually exclusive?

### GROWING TOGETHER | Spiritual Friendship

What are some ways you can play a role in the restoration or encouragement of someone within your group?

### LIVING IN 4D | Missional Living
