	GROWING TOGETHER Spiritual Friendship For we do not want you to be unaware, brothers, of the affliction we experienced in Asia. For we were so utterly burdened beyond our strength that we despaired of life itself. (2 Corinthians 1:8)
	Why is it important to be brutally honest about how things are going— namely sharing those things with people you trust, and who want to know what's going on with you?
	Indeed, we felt that we had received the sentence of death. But that was to make us rely not on ourselves but on God who raises the dead. (2 Corinthians 1:9)
