



Guidelines for Fundraising Events at Crossroads

- Crossroads Church supports our ministries through the contributions of our congregation to the General Fund.
- Additional funds may be raised on Crossroads Campuses by a ministry with the following guidelines:
 - Fundraising projects are restricted to those events or products that do not provide a profit towards individuals or companies.
 - The church directory and membership database are the property of the church and should not be used as a point of contact for fundraising.
 - Fundraising projects should support an activity or event within the ministry and not the ministry itself.
 - All goods or services that are included in the fundraiser are considered a contribution and available on a donation basis.
 - Groups from outside the church body will be discouraged from doing fund raising events on our campuses.
 - Any “Special Offering” used to raise funds for an event or activity will be approved by the Church Council.
 - Church staff is not eligible for financial compensation because of their participation in a fundraising event.
- Members of the congregation may designate their funds toward a specific ministry.
- Strategic Partners may do fundraising events, as approved by goServe Committee.
- Exception to the policy: Faith Force is allowed two fundraisers, Peaches and Christmas Wreaths.
